**Member Agreement:**

Members agree to pick up produce at the agreed upon place and time. If produce is not picked up and prior arrangements have not been made, that week's share will be forfeit and dispersed. Prior arrangement must be made for vacation dates at least one week in advance in order for HSEI CSAE to try to accommodate requests. We reserve the right, based on availability, to determine the possibility of make-up dates, or you may donate your share for that week to a friend or to be dispersed among members. **HSEI CSAE Agrees to:** provide weekly organic lettuce from Friendly Aquaponics, and variety of freshpicked, seasonally-available produce. Variety and quantity of each kind of produce is at the discretion of HSEI CSAE based on harvest availability, which includes certain risks of flood, drought, and predation that HSEI CSAE will do our best to minimize or mitigate.

We pledge our best effort to ensure crop success using sustainable methods, to limit membership enrollment to manageable numbers ensuring quantity and quality for all members, to maintain open communication with our members, and to continue learning and growing in sustainable agriculture and in partnership with our member community.

We commit ourselves to using recyclable and reusable materials and eliminating the use of plastics as part of our larger commitment to our community and the planet.
